PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Members,

Last Wednesday, the Board met via teleconference to discuss what steps we should take to do our part to both comply with the state mandates that had been implemented as well as try to plan for both the immediate and long-term schedules for the Guild. While we all agreed that postponing the remainder of our productions was necessary and that canceling was also a possibility, we tried to weigh all options as best we could while considering the safety of our members and patrons first. The decision was made to postpone Follies to June for the time being and reconvene in the near future to revisit that decision. There is also the rescheduling of the Civil War program and Playwrights Showcase to consider as well. While many good ideas were presented and questions asked, what we lacked were answers and ideas for a time frame. We hoped that more time would provide more answers and while we know a little more now, a week later, there are still no clear answers as to when life may return to something closer to "normal" or when plans may start to be made for future performances. The Board will meet again, likely much sooner than the regular scheduled meeting in early April, to re-evaluate things. Until then we will wait and follow the guidelines provided to us by state and federal officials. Thank you all for your patience and understanding during this time of uncertainty and rest assured, we are monitoring the situation and exploring all options and ideas that are presented. or a text can have profound effects on one's emotional and mental health. If you have been wondering how someone is doing, please pick up the phone and foster a sense of camaraderie within our guild.

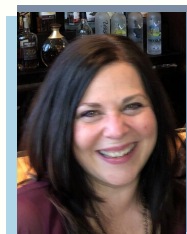
TIPS FOR PREVENTING THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 IN 7 STEPS:

Staci joined The Players Guild of Leonia in 2005 when cast as Cordelia (the Kosher caterer) in *Falsettos*. Other main productions in which she has performed here include *Starting Here*, *Starting Now*, *Lucy in You're a Good Man Charlie Brown*, *Roz in Moon Over Buffalo*, and *The Vagina Monologues*. She has performed in the Playwrights Showcase, several workshops (including *Mary in Merrily We Roll Along* and *Shanka in The Circle of Compassion*), and can be counted on for comic entertainment at the Holiday Party. Behind the scenes, she co-produced *Guys and Dolls*, served on the Board for 3 years, chaired the Makeup /Hair Committee and taught a series of improvisation classes, which culminated in a workshop performance. You can always depend on Staci to help with ticket sales for each show. When not at the Guild, Staci performs in a variety of cabaret venues in NYC and is active at BCP. In her "other life" she is an LCSW and coordinates the Reflections and RISE teen improvisational theater programs, run by the county. She wrote a chapter in the book *Interactive & Improvisational Drama: Varieties of Applied Theater and Performance* and is an adjunct professor who teaches social work classes.
